- **Michigan – “Fostering Regional Cooperation to Build a CAP-Compliant Path: Funding, Dual Path Delivery Models and Access from Warning Input Points,”** presented by Larry Estlack, Director of Technology, Michigan Association of Broadcasters, and Chairman, Michigan State Emergency Communications Committee (SECC), and Michigan Emergency Alert System.
- **Maine – “A Small State’s Approach to Implementing CAP,”** presented by Suzanne Goucher, President & CEO, Maine Association of Broadcasters.
